S.no	Scope of work	Fee details in rupees
1.	Application Fee	10000/-
2.	Document review fee	10000/-
3.	Site inspection fee	20000/- man-day
4.	Certification fee	10000/-

Note: -

- a. Man-day are calculated as per fire safety Scheme guidance document reference
- b. GST as applicable on actual basis extra
- c. Inspection team travel & accommodation expenses on actual basis
- d. One Manday equal to 8 hrs.
- e. Prospective client needs to process fee prior to inspection
- f. As and when the fee undergoes a change, the same will be communicated to all clients with whom ASPL has an ongoing contract under this scheme of inspection for their acceptance.

Inspection man-day for FSIS

The man days required to conduct a fire safety inspection are calculated in accordance with the following:-

S No.	Type of Unit	Height	Floor Area (m2)	No. of Man Days* per block
1.	Hospital Unit per Building Block	Less than 15m	Not more than 500 m2 on each floor	2
2.	Hospital Unit per Building Block	Less than 15m	More than 500 m2 on each floor	6
3.	Hospital Unit per Building Block	More than 15m	Not more than 500 m2 on each floor	4
4.	Hospital Unit per Building Block	More than 15m	More than 500 m2 on each floor	6

* In case of Hospital Unit comprising of multiple blocks, the total number of man days shall be determined based on criterion given in the table above subject to mutual agreement between ASPL & HU on having more than one team working simultaneously in the premises.

- The inspection programmer has included at least one man-day (8 hrs.) per building block on-site inspection.
- Pre-inspection meeting, Inspection preparation, de-briefing and report preparation time will be limited to one man-day only.
